

Staircase Details

All first years live in college, and all pay the same for their rooms - but they're all a bit different! Here's a rundown of the rooms in each staircase - it's worth mentioning that there's no 'bad room' (phew!)

Second Quad

Staircase 6

- What college calls a 'double set'-- unarguably the best type of room to host pre's because of the large living quarters
- Two bedrooms attached to the living room with single beds
- Sofas, desks bookshelves and wardrobes are in the living room
- Fridge and a bathroom shared between two students, in the living quarters.
- Overlooks the quad and market street

Staircase 8

- Double set
- Pretty much the same as Staircase 6

Staircase 12

- Double Set
- External bathroom - but key card access (either shared between a room of 2 or the entire staircase)
- Fridge is shared between 2 situated in the living quarters

Staircase 13

- Double Set
- Two external bathrooms on this staircase, shared with the other inhabitants of this staircase
- A medium-ish sized fridge in each room
- Sofa, desks and shelves in the living quarters

- Two bedrooms attached to the living room - each with a wardrobe, chest of drawers and a sink
- Single beds

Organ Scholar

- Two conjoined rooms: living room with piano, armchairs, large desk, lots of shelving and plenty of space for belongings; bedroom with chest of drawers, wardrobe, single bed and washbasin.
- Central location (2nd Quad).
- The water pipes travel through the bedroom room so there's a constant hiss (not too loud) - something to get used to! Shared fridge with rest of St13 so space is limited.
- Washing up in the washbasin is tricky because of the awkward angle of the taps.
- Bathrooms on ground and second floors (not ensuite): both good.

Third Quad

Staircase 17

- Rooms 7-10 share a toilet and shower room.
- Rooms 9 and 10 have sleeping room and study room.
- Rooms 7, 7A, and 8 have the desk and bed in the same room.
- All equipped with private sink and mini fridge.
- Located above the library
- Top floor (rooms 11+) have an ensuite, sleeping room, and study room.
- All members of staircase 17 have access to a spare toilet on the top floor.

Staircase 18

- Ensuite

- Mini fridge in each room with tiny freezer compartment that does not keep stuff frozen
- Most beds are small doubles (you can use single sheets anyway because really they're halfway between single and double) but a few of the rooms only have a single bed (18.20, 18.13, 18.27)

Staircase 19

- Share a toilet and fridge between 2.
- Modern building.
- Above JCR.
- Two separate rooms with their own living areas.

Ship Street Centre

- There are 3 disabled access rooms and a lift, plus each room has heating and air conditioning (very useful in summer).
- Ensuite, mini fridges in each room
- Rooms are significantly smaller (unless you have a disabled access room) than rooms in other staircases in college
